Notes and Ideas for teachers/Worksheets to accompany Miss Punk Chewation and her Crew to the Rescue

What is a letter?

There are two worksheets to choose from, the first gives you letters to select. On the second sheet children can choose their own letters. They might like to use some letters from their names or from a friend's name.

Full Stop

An easy worksheet, where children get to put full stops at the end of the lines.

What is a capital letter?

There are two worksheets to choose from, the first gives you letters to select. On the second sheet write in the letters that you want the children to work on or children might choose the letters from a friend's name.

Capital letters

From a line of letters children choose the correct ones to start the sentences, as a follow up activity get children to write down the names of their friends, then circle the ones that need to be a capitals.

Comma

This worksheet provides sentences for children to attempt finding the correct place for commas.

The Spaces

There are two worksheets to choose from, the first has wording taken from the story, children need to add the correct letters. They can check their attempts with the book. On the second sheet the children choose a friend's name to write on the sheet.

Straight Lines

This worksheet provides examples of writing that is not in a straight line, children add the correct letters to see how the writing should look when it has spaces.

Exclamation Mark

There are two worksheets, the first provides gaps where the children decide whether to put in a full stop or an exclamation mark. On the second sheet, the children can put in a friend's name instead of the letters.
